coast	The place where the land meets the sea or ocean.

navigator	A person who uses maps or special instruments to plan and direct the route of a ship, aircraft or other form of transport.
ocean	A large area of salt water that covers much of the Earth's surface. The five oceans of the world are the Arctic, Atlantic, Indian, Pacific and Southern.
sea	A body of salt water not as large as an ocean and often nearly surrounded by land.
